

Country Report

20th Meeting of the ASEAN Working Group on Forest Products Development Malaysia 24-25 July 2017

- The draft guidelines to establish a national certification system in the country was presented to different stakeholders for a new round of policy consultation
- While waiting for its approval and issuance, a series of information and awareness activities on forest certification is being done to a wide range of stakeholders including consumers

- The Interim National Governing Board (INGB) established in 2016 started its work waiting for the issuance of the guidelines for the establishment of forest certification in the country
- INGB members undergone Capacity building on Forest Certification
- The road map for the establishment of forest certification system was drafted and being finalized this year creating different technical working groups and a secretariat to administer its work.

For standard setting, a Technical Committee organized by the Bureau of Philippine Standards started to work on the draft standards for forest and forest products

Currently the Committee is working on the standards for Chain of Custody

Related Initiatives:

- We are on the completion stage in developing an electronic timber tracking system with 100% back to the stump traceability
 - Pilot testing to different types of Forest Management Unit (FMU) was planned for wider application and improvement of the system
