

OBLIGATION OF APPLICANTS

- Applicants obligate to pay royalty and premiums, forest protection fees, duty taxes, services and shall have permission for operation or imp-exportation consistent with the laws.
- Forbiddance to export/import, warning, penalty, confiscation all products as state property or revocation of applicable agreements, licenses or permits.
